Moving into Year 7 in a NSW Government school in 2022

It is time to start the transition of your child from Year 6 to Year 7.

Step 1: Obtain a copy of the EOI (Expression of Interest) form called *Moving into Year 7 in a NSW Government School in 2022.*

If your child attends a **government** primary school, this will be handed to them by the primary school.

If your child attends a **non-government** primary school, download the form from the department's High School Enrolment page, under For parents/carers.

Step 2 - Completing the Expression of Interest (EOI) form

The EOI form is to be completed by parents and carers of **all** students **requesting** placement in Year 7 at a NSW government school next year.

- School choir
- Sport
- Student leadership

Selective school decisions?

- If your child applies for an academically selective school you must tick the box in Section D of the form, and complete Section B or C in case your daughter is not successful in gaining a place at a selective school.
- Once students receive selective offers and they decline BGHS, the school will refer to the waiting list if we are below our enrolment cap set by the department.

Step 3 - Who decides?

- A small number of non-local students <u>may</u> be made offers and the rest will be placed on a waiting list in priority order.

Step 4- Complete the Student Enrolment Form sent from Burwood GHS and return with requested further documentation directly to Burwood GHS.

- The final decision on enrolment will be made following consideration and acceptance of your application to enrol by the Principal.
- Acceptance letters will be sent to successful students early September.

Step 5 – Get to know your new school

- Days 1 and 2, 2022 Year 7 Orientation
- Year 7 Camp early in 2022 to build friendships
- Week 1, 2022 Parent Information Evening
