Traineeships & Apprenticeships

- There are some school-based traineeships and apprenticeships available for students who have a clear career goal
- These combine paid work, training and school
- As well as an industry recognised national qualification, students gain credit towards the HSC
- Requires commitment, given missing a day off school
- Talk to Mr Hegedus for further information. Mr Hegedus will email information to students and parents.



University Prerequisites

- USYD and Mathematics (Advanced)
- Education degrees

Assumed Knowledge and Bridging Courses

- Universities expect that you have studied the HSC subjects they list as being 'Assumed knowledge'. If you don't do the subjects indicated, you may have difficulty coping with your university studies.
- Bridging courses are available if you do not study the HSC subjects which are 'Assumed knowledge'
