

Year 11 Jindabyne Camp 2022



Dear Students, Parents and Carers,

For more than 30 years, Year 11 students at Burwood GHS have enjoyed participating in the Year 11 Camp held at **Jindabyne Sport and Recreation Centre**. The school has a long association with the centre and continues to be rewarded with camp dates at the peak of the winter season. Students, parents and staff have always responded very positively to this camp and the school intends to continue to offer this opportunity to Year 11 students in 2022.

The Camp Program for Year 11 students at Jindabyne has a focus on snow sports, self-reliance, goal setting, communication and decision making, in an exhilarating physical environment. Each morning students are engaged in ski or snowboarding lessons with qualified instructors and spend the rest of the day practising their skills on the mountain slopes. All transport and meals are provided throughout the day, and students are supervised and accompanied by the centre staff and Burwood teachers. Evening activities are well structured and allow students to participate in a range of challenges after the day's physical activities. Accommodation is provided in modern and secure lodges with good facilities.



The Year 11 Jindabyne Camp is a unique and rewarding experience for students who will remember it as a highlight of their time at Burwood Girls High School.

Date: Students will depart on Sunday 14 August 2022. The duration of the camp is for a six-

day period during Week 5 of Term 3, with students returning to school in the afternoon of

Friday 19 August.

Activities The Winter Program includes 4 days of skiing/snowboarding in the Kosciuszko National

included: Park and participation in a range of core activities.

Supervision: The students are fully supervised at all times by the accompanying staff from Burwood

Girls High School and the resident teaching staff of the centre.









Cost: The **total** cost for the Winter Camp Program is \$1,200.00 (the camp is an educational program with GST exemption for transport, accommodation, equipment hire, lessons and lifts, however GST is paid on the food component). The total cost includes:

- all meals and accommodation for the six-day period
- coach transport from Sydney to the Jindabyne Centre and return to Sydney
- daily transport to Perisher Blue via Ski Tube and entry into the National Park
- · all activities
- ski lift ticket pass for the 4 days of skiing/snowboarding
- ski/snowboard lessons for 4 days
- hire of all ski/snowboard equipment for 4 days.
- Hire of snow clothing is NOT included in the cost, and is paid at the venue. For prices, please see Mr. Richardson or Ms. Mielcarz.

Deposit:

- A deposit of **\$400.00** must be paid to the school office **as soon as possible** to confirm your participation in the Year 11 Camp.
- The deposit must be paid before Friday 29 April 2022, so that the school may confirm its placement in this year's Jindabyne Winter Program.
- Online payments are preferred by the school. Making payments online is convenient for parents
 and reduces the need for the school to handle cash. Use the MAKE A PAYMENT feature on our
