

## **BURWOOD GIRLS HIGH SCHOOL P&C TREASURER'S REPORT 2021**

Burwood Girls High School P&C continues to support the efforts of the school assisting in providing facilities and equipment. The funds under the auspices of the BGHS P&C, are available to support our students both current and future to enhance their learning experience.

Our contribution this year has been significant and continues the trend of increasing Grants activity over the last three years.

The sources of income in 2021 were:

- Community Building Partnership & Grants - \$15,000
- Uniform Commission - \$11,723
- Parent Contributions - \$37,063
- Other Grants - \$6,000
- Financial members - \$70

The money raised, after expenses is contributed to the school as voted on by the P & C and dispersed for specific projects to the benefit of our students.

This year, income has been received from a number of areas and we have been successful in securing \$21,000 in Government Grants. In a year of uncertainty, the P&C did not have any fundraising initiatives this year.

Due to an oversight in previous years, the P&C had its registration as a charity revoked for failing to submit the Annual Information Statement (AIS) with the ACNC for two years in succession. After considerable effort and the resubmission of all the AIS' since 2016, including a charity registration application, the P&C was successfully re-registered as a charity with DGR status restored via the Aust Taxation office.

From a governance point of view, we continue to maintain our focus on simplicity, transparency, accountability and financial control and our financial practices are in line with the Federation requirements. Our insurances are current and all expenses have been paid in a timely manner.

The Independent professional auditors NFPS have completed the annual audit and signed off on our accounts as a true and accurate financial standing of the P&C for 2021.
